In October 2000 the EAS Cherenkov array TUNKA has been expanded significantly. It consists now from 25 integral detectors of Cherenkov light flux based

upon the QUASAR-370 PMT and 4 detectors of light pulse shape using Thorn-EMI D668 PMT of 20 cm diameter and Winston cones. The detectors are deployed at the square $340 \times 340 \text{ m}^2$. The preliminary analysis of 2000-2001 data is presented.
