

The metallic mirrors of the MAGIC telescope

Abstract. The reflecting surface of the MAGIC experiment is a 17m. f1 parabola made by 936 mirrors. Each mirror is a $495 \times 495, \text{mm}^2$ square with spherical shape. The recent de-

velopements in the construction of metallic mirrors and their optical properties will be described.
